- 1 Apologies for absence none
- 2 To note Declarations of interest and written requests for dispensations Cllr Herman handed in notice as his wife is a council employee, Cllr Heath re church
- 3 **To Co-opt new councillor** Following the completion of the necessary legal process Ian Lewis has volunteered to be a parish councillor. All agreed he was to be co opted
- Open Forum Rev David Howell from Hope Mansell Church advised that the Church yard at Hope Mansel is full, and would therefore be giving 1 years notice to the Parish Council that he is closing the Church yard, and that costs re maintenance and insurance therefore revert to the council to be paid out of the precept.

Rev David advised that the way around this is to purchase a field or land in the area. Rev David explained that each church is run as a separate entity & so can't apply for a loan to buy a field, as it has no money. Clerk advised that the council's precept is only £2,000, which is not enough to buy a field.

The Clerk advised that Dancing Green & Newtown & Bailey Lane End aren't in the Church's area and so it is unlikely to galvanise much fundraising in support.

Cllr Elmitt requested that Rev David approach the PCC – particularly Churchwardens Mary Freeman and Fiona Leathart who know the village well –and request they in turn approach local landowners.

Rev David requested the council take notice verbally, Cllr Elmitt stated it would only accept notice in writing, and Cllr Hermon requested that Rev David puts in the notice the fact that the Church has no money to purchase additional space. Cllr Anderson asked for costs of maintenance of the Church yard over the last 10 years.

- 7 Forestry sign at Dancing Green in hand.

Concerns raised about the high water table at Dancing Green and the flooding of septic tanks into serving aquifer, causing yet more grey water into natural water supply.
